

Emergency Funds

In the event the cyber money systems are not functioning

When there is no electronic banking, no ATM's operating, no payment transfers taking place, no credit or debit cards working, and no electronic store and gas purchases possible, a person should:

#1 HAVE SOME CASH

- Mostly small bills (*\$20 and under*), some large bills for purchase of larger items.
- Place some in your home, GO-BAG, car, and deposit box
- Amount is personal – Recommended: at least one month for purchase expenses

#2 HAVE SOME BULLION COINS

- U.S. Silver coins 1964 and earlier (*dimes, quarters, 50 cent pieces*)
- U.S. Minted one ounce *Silver Eagles* 1986 to date
- U.S. Minted Gold coins: $1/10$ ounce, $1/4$ ounce, $1/2$ ounce, and 1 ounce

#3 HAVE SOME BARTER ITEMS

- Batteries of all sizes, especially D cell
- Medical supplies and medications
- Food and drink
- Ammo (*common types*)
- Fuel (*propane cylinders, white gas, lamp oil, cans of 40:1 and 50:1 small engine fuel*)
- Propane lighters

SEVEN RECOMMENDATIONS:

- #1 Have at least one month of cash
- #2 One roll of silver dimes (50)
- #3 One roll of silver quarters (40)
- #4 One roll of silver 50 cent pieces (20)
- #5 One roll of 1oz U.S Silver Eagles (20)
- #6 Have some of your long term investment in gold coins
- #7 Have barter items
