Emergency Fuel Items To Store

When your retail fuel sources are unavailable

Minimum Preparedness List:

- Propane 20# tanks** - four
- Propane 1# cylinders** - twelve
- Gasoline** - four 5-gallon containers of high octane non-ethanol *
(with added gas stabilizer and injector cleaner)
- Diesel fuel** - four five gallon containers *(if you own a diesel engine) **
- Two cycle engine fuel mix** - four 1-quart cans of 40:1 and/or 50:1
- Camp stove fuel** *(white gas)* - two one gallon cans
- Lamp oil** *(liquid wax)* - two gallons
- Kerosene** - two gallons or 25 gallons for indoor kerosene heater
- Sterno** - four large cans
- Candles** – six large jar candles, six liquid candles, and 12 clear glass prayer candles *(Dollar Tree)*
- Barbeque briquettes** - two large sacks in sealed containers
- Firewood** - two cords, split and dried *(Tamarack or Red Fir recommended)*

* When possible keep your vehicle fuel tanks full.

Some of the above items you may not use during an emergency but can be given to a neighbor or friend in need.
